

ADJUSTABLE GASTRIC BAND: Discharge advice

You should seek advice from the Clinical Nurse Specialist if you experience:

- abdominal pain
- bleeding from operation sites
- fluid leakage from your operation sites
- redness around the port site
- weight gain
- ability to eat large amounts of food but don't feel full.

If you show any of the symptoms below you must contact the Clinical Nurse Specialist immediately or go to the Accident & Emergency Department with your emergency card:

- persistent nausea and vomiting after meals
- sudden abdominal pain combined with vomiting
- pain at the port site combined with fever and chills
- repeated dark, loose smelly stools
- persistent coughing, difficulty breathing or chest pain.
