

Pre-Admission Assessment Clinic

Before you are admitted to the hospital for a procedure it is important to undergo a pre assessment to ensure that you are well enough to undergo the treatment and we have as much up-to-date information about you as possible.

Please inform us if you develop a head cold or a chest infection (where you are coughing green or yellow sputum) between now and your day of admission as this can be an anaesthetic risk. Please contact us on one of the numbers given below as we may need to postpone your planned admission until you are symptom free for two weeks.

It is important that we are aware of this as soon as possible. Therefore, if this occurs, please contact us on one of the numbers given below, as it will be necessary to defer your planned admission until you have been free of your symptoms for 2 weeks.
