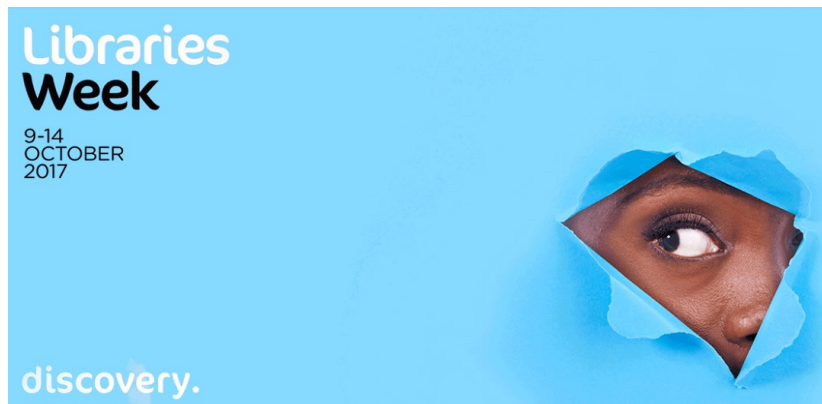

National Libraries Week 2017!

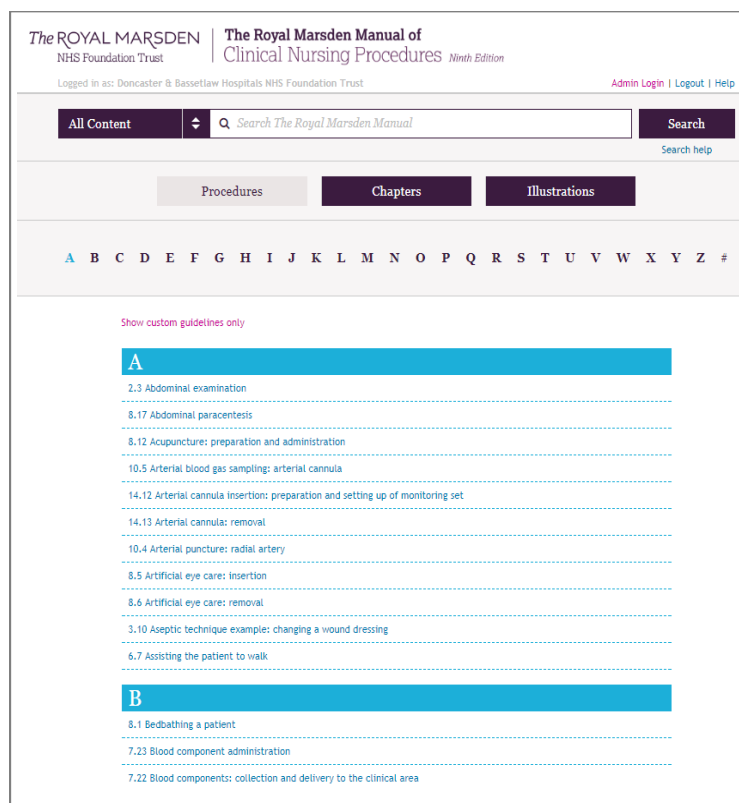
The second week in October is the first National Libraries Week. The idea is to showcase all of the creative, innovative and diverse activities that UK libraries have to offer.

Have you tried the Royal Marsden Online Manual?



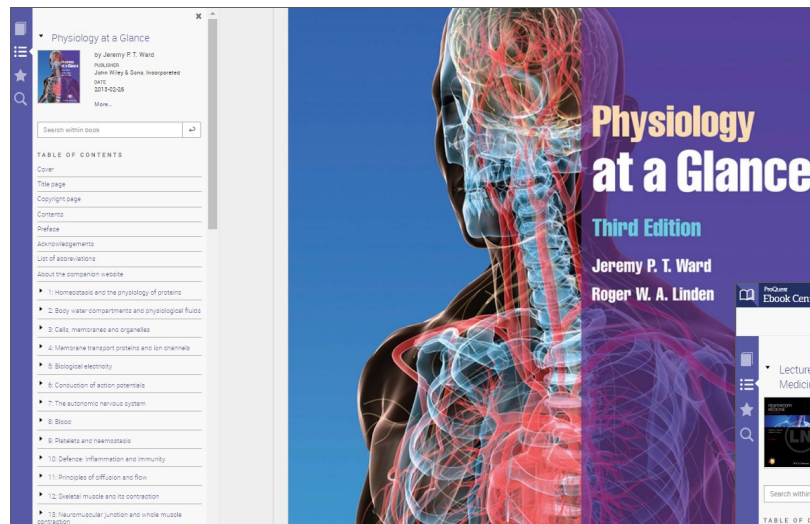
Your NHS Athens account now gives you access to the online Royal Marsden Manual of Clinical Nursing Procedures.

The Manual includes over 350 evidence-based clinical procedures related to every aspect of care, from hand-washing to cardiopulmonary resuscitation.

It takes about 5 minutes to set up an Athens account. Visit openathens.nice.org.uk and enter your details. You'll get a confirmation email & then have access to a wide range of medical information resources, e-books and databases.

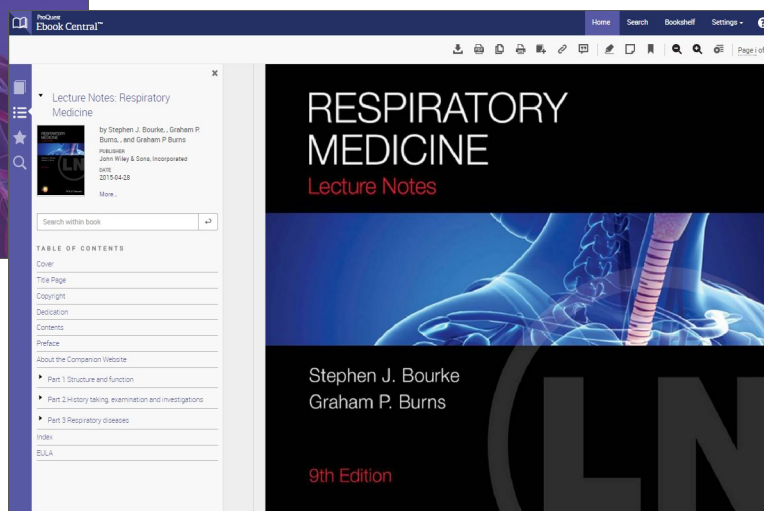
