## Prescribing Guidance:

## **Items for Restricted Prescribing:**

C1 esterase inhibitor is prescribable for the management of acute attacks of hereditary angio-oedema type 1 (C1 esterase inhibitor deficiency), and is available in 500unit vials. The dose should be 20units/kg body weight. Each vial is diluted with 10ml of normal saline, and should be given by slow intravenous injection.

Omalizumab is prescribable for severe persistent allergic asthma, if used as defined within NICE guidance.
