### **Prescribing Cautions (Finasteride):**

- Women of child bearing potential should avoid handling crushed or broken Finasteride tablets
- Finasteride is excreted in semen. Condoms should be worn if sexual partner is pregnant or may become so

### **Items for Restricted Prescribing:**

Testosterone products are prescribable by specialists for the following indications:

- Testosterone deficiency in hypogonadism or pituitary disease
- Diabetic patients with erectile dysfunction who have confirmed testosterone deficiency (see also <u>BSSM Guidelines</u>)

Injection

Testosterone enantate 250mg/ml injection Testosterone undecanoate (Nebido)
