Dear Doncaster and Bassetlaw Teaching Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust, This request relates to UK Environmental Legislation, specifically Air Conditioning Inspection Reporting, which is mandatory for UK hospital buildings which are air conditioned above a statutory minimum size.
