The DRI scanner - Siemens Aera is a large bore scanner. Any patient too large for the Bassetlaw Scanner is offered an appointment at DRI.

In the extremely unlikely event that a patient is unable to be scanned at Doncaster (there are no known cases since installation in 2011), the referring clinician is informed who will make the decision whether to refer elsewhere. Historically patients were referred to Burton Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust
