• Details of Current contract/framework details for Printed Stationery and Managed Service Print including offsite stockholding, online ordering/ consolidated invoicing — The contract between the Trust and APS is a call off contract. The Contract is for a range of print from standard NHS hospital forms i.e. history sheets, Time sheets, blood test sheets, mount sheets etc, and storage, supply and inventory management of selected stock items coupled with adhoc print on demand services.

- Communications department Print spend, and if covered contractually. No spend for printed stationery
- Start date and duration of the contract/framework 10/09/2020 09/09/2024
- Suppliers who applied for inclusion on each framework/contract and were successful & not successful at the PQQ & ITT stages.

## Direct award through RM 3785.

• Actual spend on contract/framework from the start of the contract to the current date broken down by Contractual managed stock and ad-hoc (Non-Stock) spend.

- Spend APS to date is £462,105.79 gross. The only products not attached to the APS contract were orders for the printing of envelopes cost approx. £1000.
