  - c) For the last 3 nights, the medical team have been down x1 Cover SHO. This has meant that I have been required to take up the role of FY1 and SHO on cover, covering significantly more wards than usual. This imposes a massive safety risk and jeopardises patient care due to the sheer volume of medical jobs and sick patients to review overnight.

As the medical on call team (Reg, SHO, FY1) we have discussed with the on-call Consultant, site managers and several discussions with clinical staffing all week, with no result except for further staff shortages last night.
