- What are the titles associated with each band e.g. principal podiatrist, specialist podiatrist in wound care, advanced podiatrist, specialist vascular podiatrist, diabetes specialist podiatrist etc?

- What is the grade of the manager overseeing the podiatry team and are they a podiatrist? B9 Podiatric Consultant
- Is there a consultant podiatrist in your Trust? If so, are they a Consultant in Podiatric Medicine or Consultant in Podiatric Surgery? Podiatric Surgery
