1. The NHS Trust and location (City, Town, or suburb) of all currently operational SDECs (highlighting whether they are permanent buildings, temporary/mobile units or refurbished existing estates) at your Trust.

Doncaster and Bassetlaw Teach Hospitals, Doncaster and Bassetlaw.

Doncaster Royal Infirmary site.

Medical SDEC - refurbished existing estate within the Acute Medical Unit

Surgical SDEC- refurbished existing estate within the South Block

Bassetlaw Hospital

Medical and Surgical SDEC co-located within the Acute Treatment Centre, refurbished existing estate.

2. The NHS Trust and location (City, Town, or suburb) of all planned permanent, temporary or refurbished SDECs that are not yet operational at your Trust.

2024/2025 Transformation plans for the Trust are looking at potential pathways which will be beneficial for a SDEC provision. The plans are yet to be completed and sign off.

3. What is the maximum patient occupancy of the SDEC (number of patients in chairs or number of patients in beds)?

Doncaster Medical – 18 Chairs, 3 trolleys, 1 single room

Doncaster Surgical- 16 Chairs, 2 trolleys

Bassetlaw Med/ Surg co-located – 12 Chairs, 1 trolley, 1 recliner

Medical SDEC Doncaster- Average 867

Surgical SDEC Doncaster – Average 491

Medical SDEC Bassetlaw- Average 344

Surgical SDEC Bassetlaw- Average 75
