Pathway for Patient with Wounds and Complex Lives

Aim: To deliver wound care intervention for hard to reach groups.

1. Patient presents at a Primary or Secondary service with an open wound

2. Treat the wound as per the Doncaster Wide Wound Care Formulary Pathways and or the local suspected DVT pathway.

3. Does the patient meet the following criteria?

- Local to Doncaster
- Under Aspire Drug & Alcohol Services
- Cycle of rough sleeping/ no fixed abode
- No GP or Non- Compliant with GP appointments and meets another area of the criteria
- Substance misuse/offending behaviour
- Tier 3 or below wound.

Refer patient to Complex Lives clinic
