

# Pathway for Patient with Wounds and Complex Lives

**Aim: To deliver wound care intervention for hard to reach groups.**

**1. Patient presents at a Primary or Secondary service with an open wound**

**2. Treat the wound as per the Doncaster Wide Wound Care Formulary Pathways and or the local suspected DVT pathway.**

**3. Does the patient meet the following criteria?**

- Local to Doncaster
- Under Aspire Drug & Alcohol Services
- Cycle of rough sleeping/ no fixed abode
- No GP or Non- Compliant with GP appointments and meets another area of the criteria
- Substance misuse/offending behaviour
- Tier 3 or below wound.
