Under the Freedom of Information Act, I would like to request the following information:

After careful consideration, we regret to inform you that we are unable to provide the requested information. Our data systems only capture details of patients who have attended the hospital and received a diagnosis within our care. However, this does not necessarily mean that the diagnosis was made by our hospital, as some patients may have been diagnosed elsewhere before attending our services.

As a result, we do not hold the specific data required to determine the average time from GP referral to diagnosis. You may wish to contact NHS England or local Clinical Commissioning Groups (CCGs), as they may hold broader data on diagnostic pathways.

If you are not satisfied with the handling of your request, you have the right to request an internal review. Requests for an internal review should be submitted within 40 working days from the date of this response, and should be addressed to d.wraith@nhs.net.

If you remain dissatisfied after the internal review, you have the right to appeal to the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO). The ICO can be contacted at:
