After careful consideration, we have decided to withhold the requested information under Section 36(2)(b) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 – Prejudice to the Effective Conduct of Public Affairs.

The information you have requested relates to ongoing strategic workforce and financial planning, which is subject to change based on evolving factors such as budget allocations, staffing demands, and national healthcare policies. Disclosing this information at this stage could undermine the Trust's ability to make informed and flexible decisions, as well as lead to public misunderstanding or unnecessary speculation about future staffing and cost-saving measures.

Releasing this information prematurely may also impact negotiations with staffing agencies and workforce suppliers, potentially affecting the Trust's ability to secure cost-effective staffing solutions.

While we recognize the public interest in transparency around NHS workforce and financial planning, we believe that withholding this information at this stage is necessary to protect the integrity of decision-making processes and ensure effective resource management.

In applying this exemption, we have conducted a public interest test to assess whether the benefits of disclosure outweigh the potential harm.

Public interest factors in favour of disclosure:

- Transparency around NHS financial and workforce planning supports public accountability.
- Disclosure could provide insight into how the Trust is working to manage temporary staffing costs effectively.
- It may allow for public scrutiny of NHS spending and resource allocation.

Public interest factors in favour of withholding:

• The information relates to ongoing strategic workforce and financial planning, which is subject to change based on factors such as budgetary constraints, workforce availability, and national healthcare policies. Premature disclosure could mislead the public or create unnecessary speculation.

- Releasing this information may compromise the Trust's ability to negotiate effectively with staffing agencies and workforce suppliers, potentially leading to higher costs and reduced financial efficiency.
- Publishing early projections may restrict organisational flexibility, making it harder to adapt plans to changing workforce pressures or unexpected developments.
- Disclosure could discourage frank and open discussions within the organisation about workforce strategies, thereby hindering effective decision-making.
