

## Freedom of Information Act Request

I am writing to request information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

How many new patients were treated by the Trust's Gastroenterology Department in the latest 3-month period of November, December and January (or the latest 3 months available) with the treatments I have provided below?

Please can you define a "new patient" as a patient who has received any of the treatments listed below for the first time. If a patient received any of the below treatments before the 1st November 2025, they are not classed as a new patient for the purposes of this question.

Where figures are fewer than five, they have been replaced with "#".

This is because the disclosure of very small numbers, particularly when combined with other information provided (such as year, service area or site), may risk the identification of individuals. The Trust has therefore applied small number suppression in accordance with **Section 40(2) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (Personal Data)**.

Section 40(2) exempts information from disclosure where it constitutes personal data and where disclosure would be unfair or unlawful under the UK General Data Protection Regulation and the Data Protection Act 2018.

Replacing small numbers with "#" helps ensure that individuals cannot be identified from the information provided.
