Freedom of Information Act Request

I am writing to request information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Can I request for question 1. Annual number of patients diagnosed with blood cancers per year overall, and by subtype:

- Lymphomas (C81-86)
- Malignant immunoproliferative diseases (C88)
- Multiple myeloma and malignant plasma cell neoplasms (C90)
- Leukaemia (C91-C95)
- Unspecified malignant neoplasms of lymphoid, haematopoietic and related tissues (C96), that it be narrowed to the past 3 years i.e. 1st Jan 2023 - 31st Dec 2025?

Doncaster and Bassetlaw Teaching Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust does not hold the information requested. The reporting of haematological samples are done via HODS and is based in STH (Sheffield Teaching Hospital)

Pathology services at DBTH are now delivered through South Yorkshire and Bassetlaw Pathology (SYBP) Services, which is hosted by Sheffield Teaching Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust. DBTH is a partner trust within this hosted arrangement.
