

Freedom of Information Act Request

I am writing to request information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

1. Does your trust operate a recurrent miscarriage clinic or specialist recurrent pregnancy loss service?

No. The Trust does not operate a dedicated recurrent miscarriage clinic or specialist recurrent pregnancy loss service.

Patients who meet the relevant clinical criteria are instead seen within general Gynaecology Outpatient Department (GOPD) clinics.
