I am writing to request information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

I would be grateful if you could please supply answers to the following questions:

1. How many mortuaries are operated by your Trust? (if none, please respond 'none')
2. For each mortuary your Trust operates, please provide:
 - a. The name of the mortuary
 - b. The total number of admissions per year, for the years 2020-2025
 - c. The total number of autopsies per year, for the years 2020-2025
 - d. The types of autopsy completed (e.g. consented hospital coroners, community coroners, paediatric, forensic, category 3 high-risk)
 - e. The job titles and FTE status for each member of staff employed in the mortuary (please include staff who are based solely in the mortuary, not cross-covering other departments)
